Finland's leading squash player Olli Tuominen has enjoyed a consistently successful career on the PSA World Tour since joining the PSA in 1997.

And, despite turning 32 in April 2011 - and boasting a career-high world ranking of 13 more than five years earlier - Tuominen crashed back into the world top 20 in June after a 25-month absence from the elite list.

Tuominen claimed his maiden Tour title at the Lakeshore Classic in the USA in 1998 – but achieved one of the best runs of his career in 2010 when he reached three finals, with title triumphs in two.

It was in February 2010 that the 'Flying Finn' celebrated his third successive title success in the Finnish Open, beating compatriot Henrik Mustonen in the established event's first ever all-Finnish final.

A month later he triumphed again in the Pacific Athletic Club Open, winning the 10th Tour title of his career in the US 2-star event.

But in September, Tuominen recorded his 16th final appearance in the Colombian Open – reaching the final in Bogota without dropping a game, before bowing out to local hero Miguel Angel Rodriguez.

The Helsinki-based Tuominen began his 2011 campaign with a last 16 berth in the North American Open unseeded – then made it through to the last eight of the Irish Open in Dublin.

But his best success of the year to date came in May in Egypt where, again unseeded, he reached the last four of the Hurghada International. His breakthrough came in the opening round when he ousted fourth-seeded Frenchman Thierry Lincou – his semi-final berth in the PSA International 70 event pushing him back into the world top 20 the following month.
